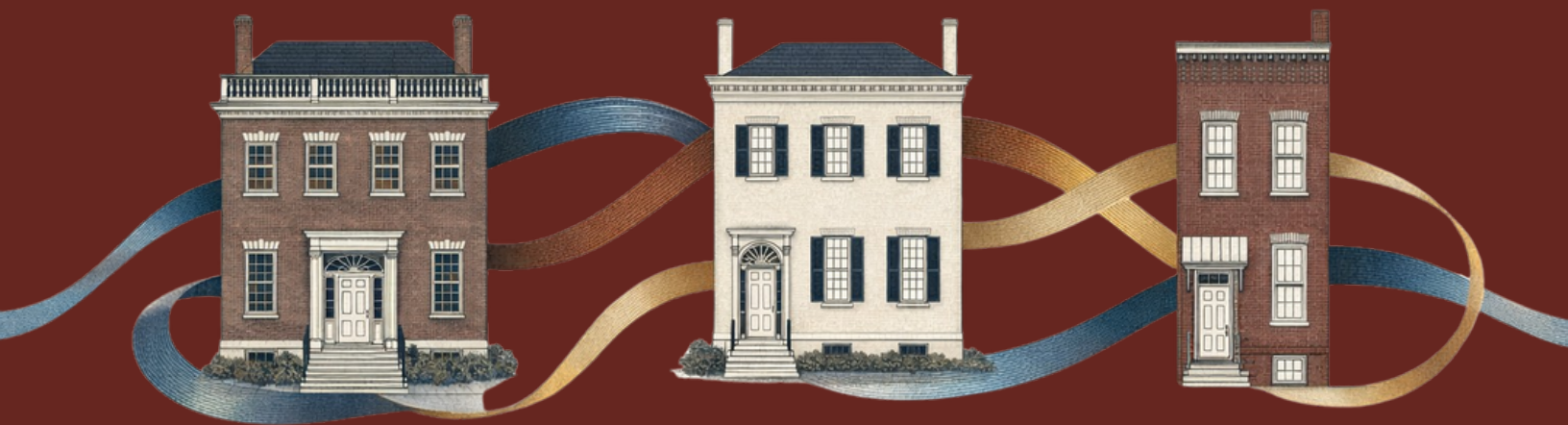

Architectural Styles



Georgian homes are defined by symmetry, balance, and formal spatial organization

Trinity homes are compact, vertical row houses characteristic of Philadelphia's urban fabric that create intimate living environments

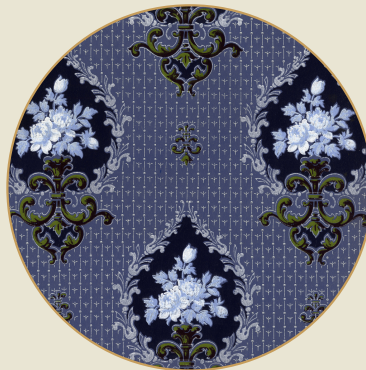

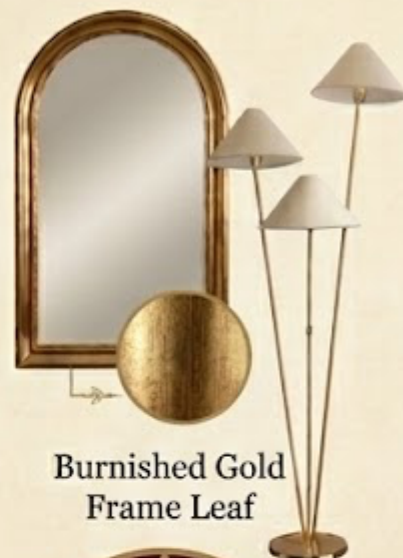
